Saptashrungi Bahuuddeshiya Mahila Sanstha has been doing social work through various projects since 2006. For example, Childline 1098 Helpline Project for children in the age group of 0 to 18 years, Maharashtra AIDS Control Institute Mumbai Assisted Link Worker Scheme Project, as well as Target Intervention Project, Adarshgaon Yojana, Farmers, Environment, Health related and various schemes have been provided to the needy. During the Covid-19 lockdown, which started in the year 2020, grocery distribution and medical aid were provided.

Link Worker Scheme Project

The Link Worker Project was started on January 1, 2014 through Maharashtra State AIDS Control Institute, Mumbai. Seeing the successful work of the Link Worker Project done by the organization in 2018-19, the Maharashtra State AIDS Control Organization gave the link worker project to the organization. Under the Link Worker project, HIV awareness work is being done in 100 villages. The project was found to have significantly reduced the HIV prevalence of the villages in the project.

Child line 1098 Project

Help line service

Child line 1098 project implemented by Saptashrungi Multipurpose Women's Organization Dhule with the support of Ministry of Women and Child Development is being implemented in Dhule district for children in the age group of 0 to 18 years. This is when you see a sick and lonely child. When you see a child in need of shelter. When you see a child is lost, or abandoned. When you see a child is not paid his / her salary. When you see a child being bullied / beaten on the street. When you want to volunteer for Childline for free.

- 1) A 3 month meeting of DCPC was held on 24/2/2021 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Collector Dhule. It reviewed the work done from October 2020 to December 2020.



- 2) The Childline Project conducted an online essay competition for children between the ages of 0 and 18 from August 1 to September 15 on the fun you experienced during the lockdown period. A total of 48 children participated in this competition. The prize giving ceremony of the competition was held on 25/09/2020 at the Childline office. Mr.G.N.Shimpi (DWCD), Mrs. Jayashree Borase, Mrs. Meena Bhosale, President of the SBMS was present as the Chief Guest.





Today, on 18/10/2020, the program was held in the premises of All India Radio Center, Colony. The program was attended by children between the ages of 6 to 10 and 11 to 18 years. The children were introduced to the Childline 1098 project by a team member. The children were also asked about who spent their time during the lockdown.



Awareness program about Childline 1098 project was held at National Urdu High School today on 22/2/2021. Counselor Rupali Zalte informed the children about Childline 1098 and also guided the children about the rights of children, good touch, bad touch and Ansari Masood Iqbal. Organizing veterinary examination camp at Adarshgaon Wadgaon

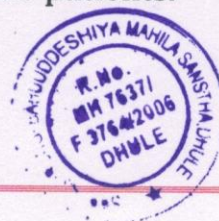

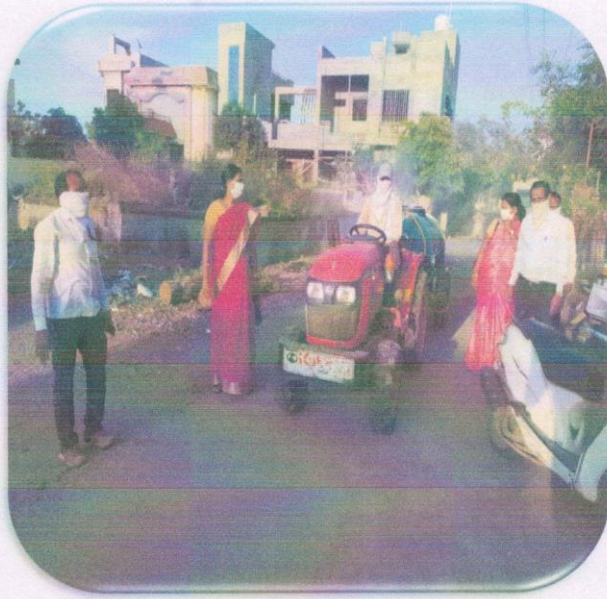

The Corona virus has caused a time of starvation in India due to the lockdown situation in the whole of India. Contacted Meena Bhosale and told her that Tai has run out of groceries. Do something for us. At that time, the organization decided to distribute enough groceries from its **own fund for 15 days** to the destitute women. Accordingly, the organization has so far distributed groceries to 122 destitute families. Due to the cancellation of the yatra, the time has come for the Tamasha artists to go hungry. Therefore, groceries were distributed to 15 women artists. Also, 36 men and women in the risk group were given health check-ups along with radiation and masks and sanitizers. A total of 46 women including widows, divorced and abandoned women from Dasvel, Kapdane and Wadgaon were given groceries and masks. Also, groceries were distributed to a total of 27 tribal families in Shirpur and Sakri. Masks and sanitizers were distributed to the boys and girls observation house, sanitation staff at the Municipal Corporation, media representatives. Groceries were also distributed to women at Mamata Ashram School. The medicines of HIV infected patients in Shirpur taluka of Dhule district as well as 27 patients from Dhule talukas were delivered by the employees of the organization. 500 masks were distributed by the organization. In case of lockdown, LWS, TI, Childline 1098 services are running 24 hours a day





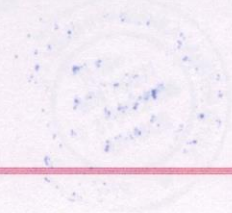
2) Celebrate World Girls Day
